Steps towards writing effective learning objectives: Make sure there is one measurable verb in each objective. Each objective needs one verb. Either a student can master the objective, or they fail to master it. If an objective has two verbs (say, define and ... Ensure that the verbs in the course ...

Using Bloom ' s Taxonomy to Write Effective Learning ...

It consists of four key elements: (A) Audience, (B) Behavior, (C) Condition, and (D) Degree. A-Audience: Determine who will achieve the objective. B-Behavior: Use action verbs (Bloom ' s taxonomy) to write observable and measurable behavior that shows mastery of the objective.

Using Bloom ' s Taxonomy to Write Effective Learning ...

Create a scenario in which a character in the story reacts to a problem in your school; write about how he or she would handle the situation differently. Reimagine the characters in a story as a human, animal, or thing. Teleport (space travel) the main character to a new setting. (Re)write lyrics to a ballad for a story you are reading.
