The physical environment within the home can also vary markedly, resulting in the community nurse requiring considerable adaptation skills to prevent or maintain control of infection: changing a dressing in a person's home where space is at a minimum might for example entail kneeling on the carpet or even on the bed and the community nurse must make the environment as safe as possible by implementing the same principles of infection control that would be adopted in hospital.

Infection control – disposing of infectious waste. To dispose of infectious waste that has been contaminated with blood or other body fluids: Wear heavy duty gloves. Place waste in plastic bags marked 'infectious waste'. Dispose of waste in accordance with EPA guidance. Workplace infection control – handling contaminated sharps

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
